ORDER 2025-88

COMMISSIONERS COURT ORDER GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT TYLER TECHNOLOGIES, INC. PROVIDES A PRODUCT AND SERVICE THAT CAN BE OBTAINED FROM ONLY ONE SOURCE

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on **September 8, 2025**, in regular session for the consideration that the Real Property and Vital Statistics software used by the County Clerk are a product and service that can be obtained from only one source. The Commissioners Court finds that that the Tyler Odyssey Enterprise Justice cloud migration services and associated software is a product and service that integrates with other software from Tyler Technologies, Inc. in use by the County and that can be obtained from only one source, which is Tyler Technologies, Inc., and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code as no other company provides the said product or service in Johnson County, Texas.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the Tyler Odyssey Enterprise Justice cloud migration services and associated software is a product that integrates with other software from Tyler Technologies in use by the County and that product can be obtained from only one source which is Tyler Technologies, Inc.
