ORDER 2025-91

ORDER REQUIRING JOHNSON COUNTY TO PROVIDE RADIO, DISPATCH, AND CLASS C JAIL SERVICES TO FIRST RESPONDERS AND AUTHORIZING JOHNSON COUNTY TO INVOICE FOR THE SERVICES RENDERED

WHEREAS, Johnson County provides Radio, Dispatch, and Class C Jail Services to multiple law enforcement and other first-responder agencies (Agency or Agencies herein) located within the County; and

WHEREAS, the standing agreement between the County and the Agencies requires the County to send an invoice to each Agency utilizing one or more of the listed Services for that Agency's pro rata share of the cost of maintaining the Service during the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, each year, the Radio Management Director and Johnson County Sheriff calculate the fee for each Agency to pay based upon the cost of providing the Service to the Agency; and

WHEREAS, typically, each Agency enters into an Interlocal Agreement with the County for the specified Service, but the execution of those Agreements is occasionally delayed beyond the beginning of each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, it is crucial that no Service be disrupted due to the delayed execution of an Agreement.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, that effective October 1, 2025, Johnson County shall continue providing the same Services that were in effect during the previous fiscal year, and **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that Johnson County shall invoice each Agency in the amount listed in Exhibit A, Exhibit B, and Exhibit C regardless of whether the Agency has executed a new Interlocal Agreement for that Service.

EXHIBIT C

INVOICE AMOUNTS FOR HOUSING MUNICIPAL CLASS C INMATES

Each Municipality placing an inmate in the Johnson County Jail to be held on a Class C Misdemeanor shall be invoiced for the current Per Day Rate (for each day the inmate is held) Plus any offsite or third-party medical or health services, any prescription drugs or treatments, any surgical or dental services, and any hospitalization expenses as well as any expenses incurred outside the ordinary costs of housing an inmate.

The Per Day Rate for FY25 is: **\$69.94**
