COUNTY OF JOHNSON

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COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE REPAIR OF THE BRIDGE ON CR 1111, A/K/A SOUTH NOLAN RIVER ROAD, IS A PURCHASE AND EXPENSE DUE TO UNFORSEEN DAMAGE TO PUBLIC PROPERTY.

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on November 17, 2025, in a special called session for the consideration of the repair to the county bridge located on CR 1111, a/k/a South Nolan River Road, due to unforeseen damage to the bridge. The Commissioners Court finds that this repair expense for the bridge located on CR1111, a/k/a South Nolan River Road, is a repair expense necessary because of unforeseen damage to the bridge which is public property, and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the repair expense to the bridge located on CR 1111, a/k/a South Nolan River Road, is an expense necessary because of unforeseen damage to the bridge which is public property, and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code. This Order is intended to cover any and all purchases of materials, rental of equipment, and contract labor as may be necessary to complete the repairs necessary to the bridge.
