Dear Mr. Boedeker,

Brazos Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (Brazos Electric) is preparing an Environmental Report (ER) to assess the anticipated environmental impacts associated with the proposed Concord to Crowley line rebuild in Johnson County, Texas. This ER is being developed in compliance with 7 CFR Part 1970 for review and approval by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Rural Utilities Service (RUS). The ER will encompass a comprehensive review and evaluation of potential environmental impacts related to land ownership, land use, historic and cultural resource preservation, threatened and endangered species, biological resources, waters of the United States, wetlands, designated floodplains, important farmlands, and hazardous materials.

This project consists of rebuilding the existing Concord to Crowley line. The Rebuild will include approximately 6.4 miles between Joshua and Concord with 1433 ACSS conductor line, approximately 0.6 miles of single circuit from Joshua to Crowley with 1433 ACSS and rebuilding approximately 2.3 miles of double circuit from Joshua to Crowley with 1433 ACSS.

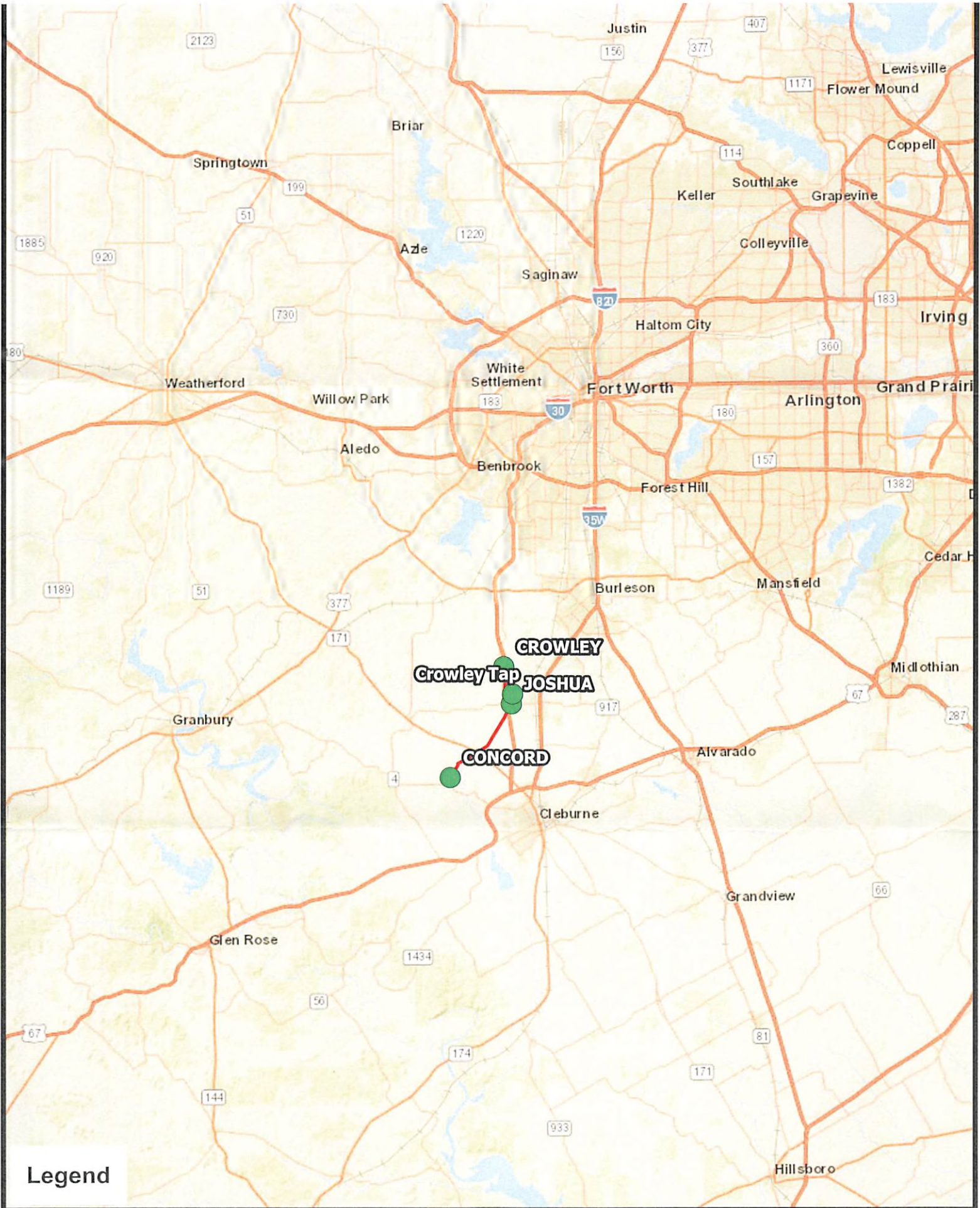
The proposed project is not anticipated to significantly impact any sensitive environmental features, including historic/cultural resources, threatened and endangered species, biological resources, jurisdictional wetlands and waterways, important farmland, and hazardous materials. No mapped or known environmentally sensitive features are located within or immediately adjacent to the proposed project area. Please reference the enclosed Vicinity Map (Figure 1). Also enclosed for your reference is an Aerial Map (Figure 2) and a Topographical Map (Figure 3). Your responses will be extremely helpful in determining the possible impacts by the proposed project.

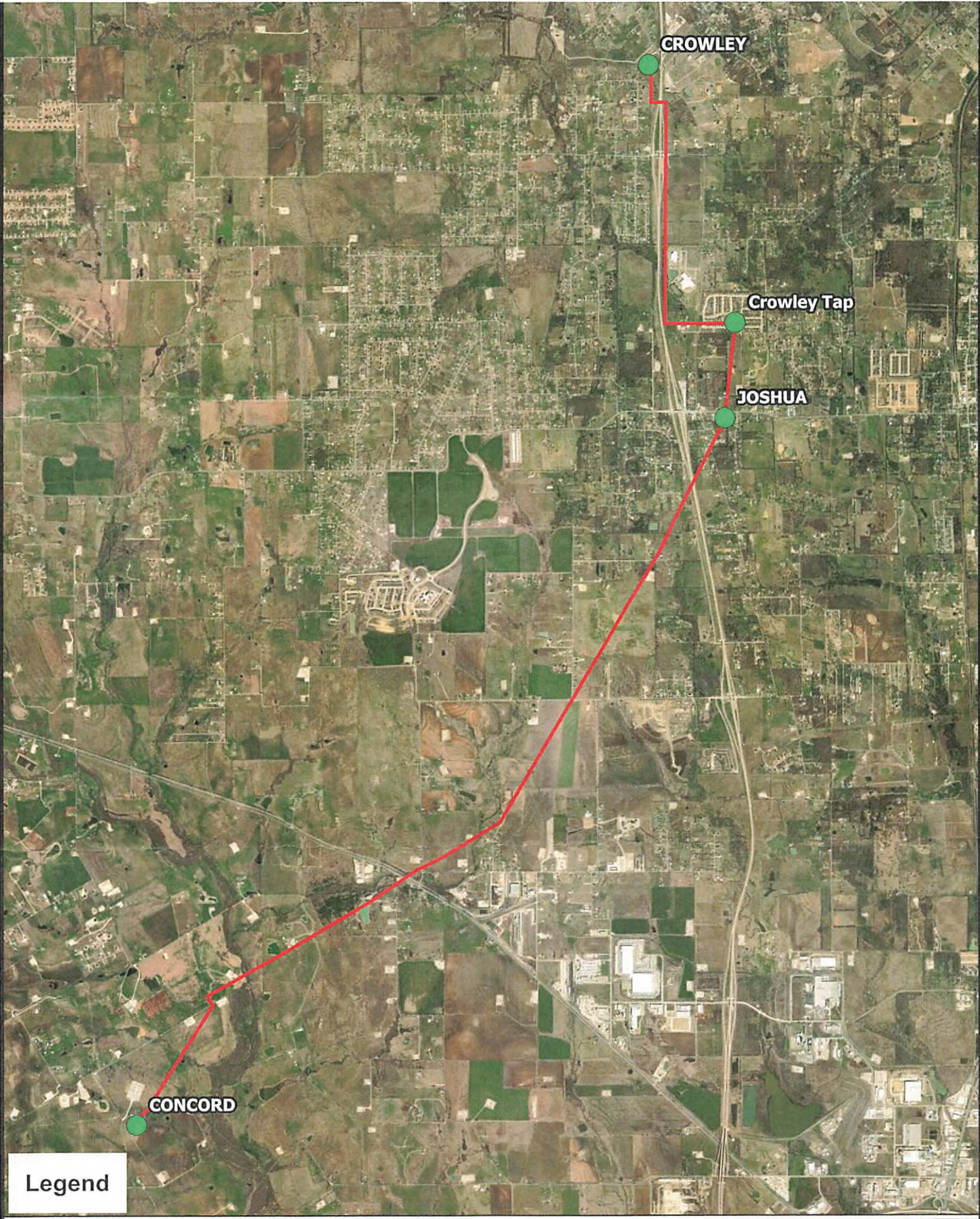
Legend

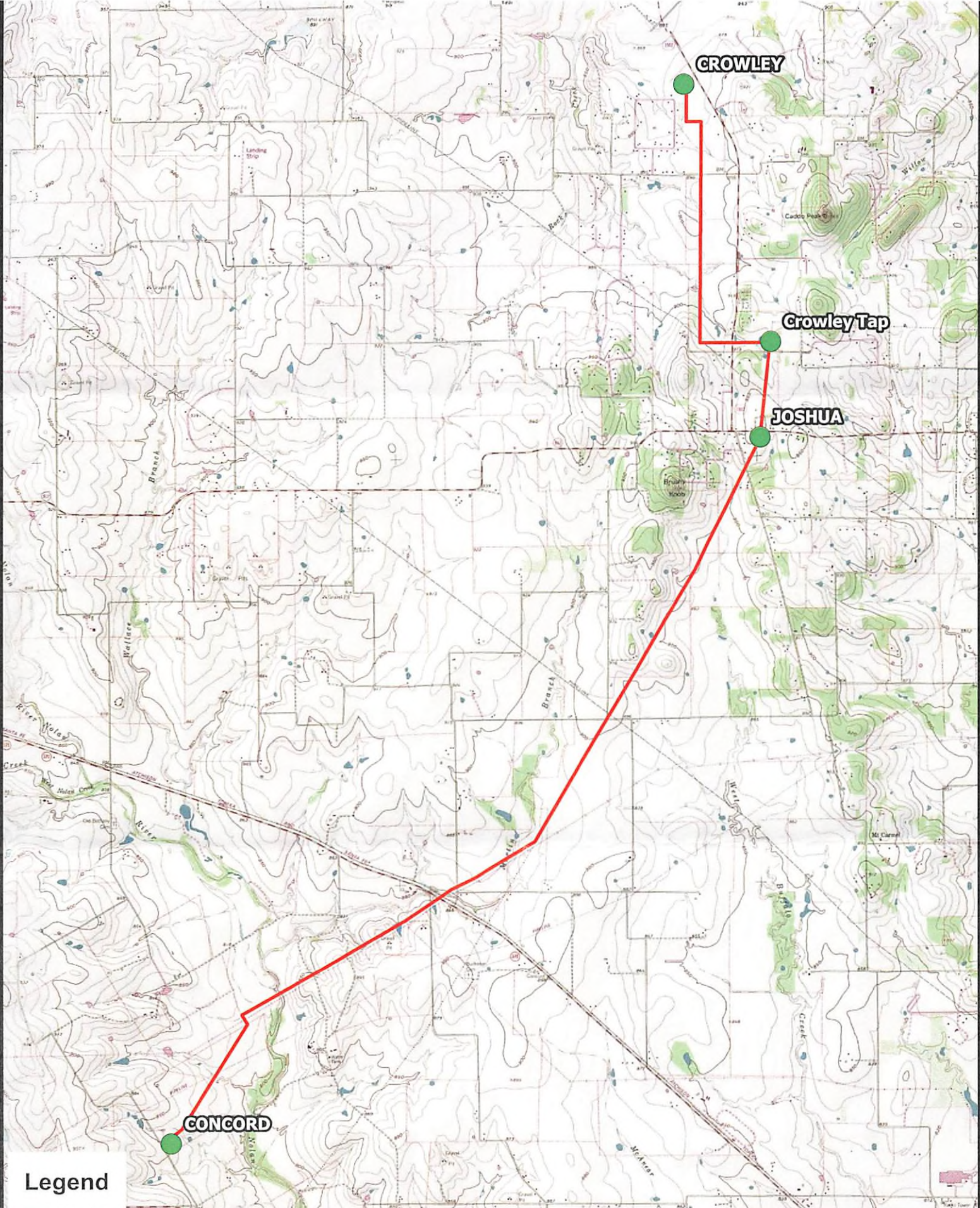

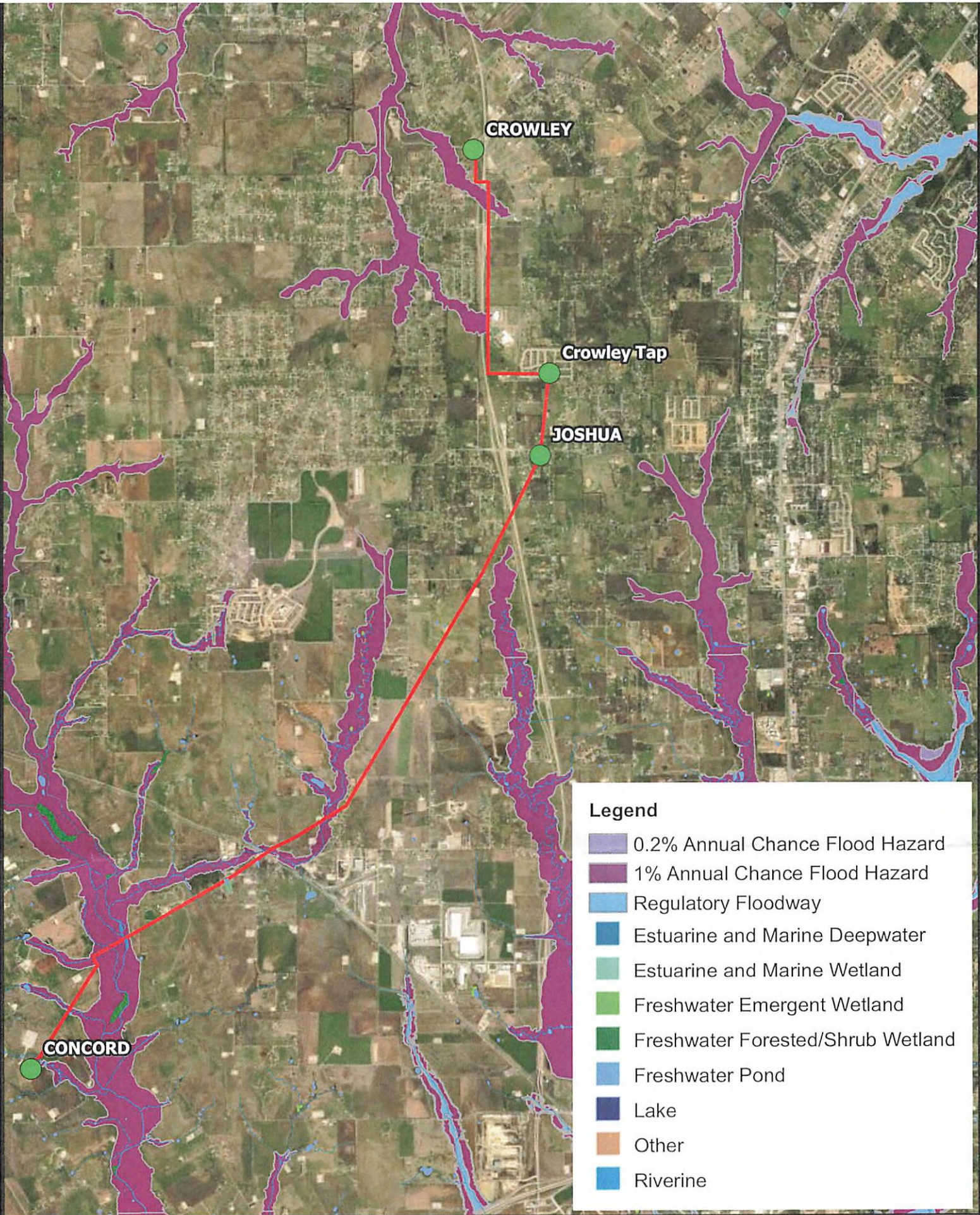
