BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a Regular Meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of April A. D. 1943, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Roy Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner H. Olin Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Dallas Thompson, Precinct #3, Commissioner M. W. Roland Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin County Clerk. The following proceedings were had:

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the report of the County Treasurer be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that J. L. Bowman Jr. be appointed as constable to fill the unexpired term of J. L. Bowman deceased, Constable of Precinct #3. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland vote "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that all properly approved bills be allowed and paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the Tax Assessor and Collector be authorized to reassess the taxes on Lots 3 & 4, Block 17 of Godley, Texas for all years delinquent and to accept \$35.00 in full payment for all years delinquent on said lot. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that Dr. Lee Yater be appointed County Health Officer. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids for a car for the Sheriff's Department with trade-in of a 1941 Chevrolet owned by the Sheriff's Department, the bids to be submitted and opened on May 1, 1943 at 10:00 a.m. The Commissioners' Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids.

Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the petition of Neal Warren and others for opening up a road 3<sup>rd</sup> class through the Barbussar and Hammer farms be refused. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt, seconded by Commissioner Hadley that W. Roy Anderson, County Judge, be authorized and empowered to execute for the County, an agreement with Gulf, Colorado and Santa Fe Railway Company and The State of Texas, pertaining to the construction and maintenance of a public road on a certain portion of the property of said Railway Company at or near Cleburne, in the County of Johnson. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the returns of School Trustee Election held April 3, 1943 having been canvassed are declared to show the following:
