(For Precinct #2) Bids to be received and opened at 10 A.M. Monday June 14, 1943. The Commissioners' Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "aye". A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the Court adjourn subject to the call of the County Judge.
