BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a Special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of July, A. D. 1943, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Thompson, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. The following proceedings were had:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that all properly approved accounts be allowed and paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the salary of C. A. Munsch as County Agent be fixed the same as that of former County Agent Williamson. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that a public hearing of the Budget be at 10:00 a.m. on Monday August 16, 1943. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the bond of C. P. Shiflet as Public Weigher at Alvarado be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the bond of B. H. Massey as Public Weigher be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson, and Roland voted "aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the valuation on 2 acres of the C. Chaney Survey assessed as the John Anderson estate be canceled for all years delinquent and reassessed at the value of \$172.00. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the Court adjourn subject to the call of the County Judge. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".
