BE IT REMEMBERED, that at a Special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of September, A. D. 1943, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Thompson, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk.

The following proceedings were had:

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that all properly approved accounts be allowed and paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the County pay \$10.00 per month to Preston Hays on his medical expense, beginning Jan. 1, 1943 and until further ordered by the court. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt, and seconded by Commissioner Thompson that the County enter into an agreement with the United States Department of Interior for a Government Trapper in Johnson County, the expense not to exceed \$80.00 per month, beginning Sept. 1, 1943 and that the County Judge be authorized to execute agreement. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley, and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the Court adjourn subject to the call of the County Judge. All voted aye.
