The bridge is to be 100 feet long and 16 foot road way according to specifications on file in the County Auditor's office. Terms cash. Bids to be opened October 1, 1943 at 10:00 a.m. The Commissioners' Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the appointment of Helen Burns as clerk in the County Attorney's office at a salary of \$50.00 per month beginning Sept. 13, 1943, be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids for repairs to the roof of the Court House under the following specifications:

Clean off material on roof to the tile. Entire deck of roof to be mopped with asphalt primer. Then lay 1 ply of 15 lb. felt over roof, then roll in 4-ply 15 lb. felt with not less than 20lb. of asphalt per square; the pour from can hop asphalt not less than 35 lbs. per square. While hot pour 400 lbs. of washed roofing gravel per square. The flashing to be 6 ply at all walls. The flashing to turn up under present counter flashing. A 20 year guarantee of this work is required with a bond to secure said guarantee, made by some Surety Co. acceptable to the Commissioners' Court. Work to be begun and completed by Nov. 15, 1943. Terms cash at completion of the job. Bids to be opened Oct. 1, 1943 at 10:00 a.m. The Commissioners Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Thompson and Roland voted "Aye".
