The following proceedings were had:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the claim of B. B. Steele for \$1720.50 for repair of the roof of the Courthouse be allowed and ordered paid. Judge Anderson, Commissioner Wyatt and Commissioner Hadley voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that Dorothy Brumfield be approved as secretary to the County Judge at a salary of \$60.00 per month beginning November 1, 1943. Judge Anderson, Commissioner Wyatt and Commissioner Hadley voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the Bond of Mrs. Jno. R. Beaver as District Clerk be approved. Judge Anderson, Commissioner Wyatt, and Commissioner Hadley voted aye.
