BE IT REMEMBERED THAT at a Special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 8th day of May A. D. 1944, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley Precinct #2, Commissioner Thompson, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. The following proceedings were had:

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that all properly approved accounts be allowed and paid. All vote aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the proposal of John F. Buckner for the repair of Chambers Creek bridge on the Grandview-Maypearl road be accepted and he be authorized to proceed with repairs as therein stated. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the Commissioners' Court will meet as a Board of Equalization on Tuesday May 16, 1944. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Tax Assessor be authorized to cancel the valuation on W1/2 lot 3, block 41 of the city of Grandview for all years delinquent and to reassess the same on the valuation to accept \$48.00 in payment of taxes. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Thompson and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Tax Assessor be authorized to cancel the valuation on lot 8 in block 7, and lot 18 in block 14 in the town of Lillian, for all years delinquent and to reassess the same on the valuation to accept \$50.00 in full settlement. All voted aye.
