BE IT REMEMBERED, That at a set meeting of the Commissioners' Court, sitting as a Board of Equilization of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 13th and 14th days of June, A. D. 1945 the following members were present to-wit: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Maddox, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, W. J. Stilwell, Tax Assessor and Collector, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Maddox that the valuation of the property belonging to J. W. Braxton, 165 acres of the N. Smith Survey, and Lots 1 and 2, Block 13 of Cresson be placed at \$330.00 and \$900.00 respectively.

Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Maddox and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the valuation of the property belonging to Alta Souther, 93 acres of the E. Melton Survey, 107 acres of the T. S. Moore Survey, and 135 acres of the M. Muckleroy Survey, be placed at \$1000.00, \$1500.00 and \$1900.00 respectively. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Maddox and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the valuation of the property belonging to W. M. Landers, N. Pt. blk, 483, be placed at \$2000.00.

Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the valuation on all property set by the Equilization Board at the first session, and as amended at the second session be fixed as assessed and the valuation placed on the value of the property on unrendered rolls be set as fixed by the Tax Assessor. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox, and Roland voted "Aye".
