BE IT REMEMBERED that at a Regular Meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 9th day of July, A. D. 1945, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley Precinct #2, Commissioner Maddox, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4 and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Petition of C. E. Wells and others for the Commissioners' Court to abandon its claim to alleys of Avondale Addition outside the City Limits of Cleburne as outlined in plat of Record in Vol. 243, Page 639, and Vol. 150, Page 640 of the Deed Records of Johnson County, Texas be granted and that the County does hereby abandon said alleys and authorize the closing of all of said alleys. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Bond of B. H. Massey as Public Weigher be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Bond of J. C. Powell as Public Weigher be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Treasurer's Report be adopted. Commissioner Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that all properly approved accounts be allowed and ordered paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".
