BE IT REMEMBERED that at a Regular Meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 10th day of September, A. D. 1945, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Maddox, Precinct #3, and Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that all properly approved accounts be allowed and ordered paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Maddox and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the County pay Rev. George R. Pemberton \$70.00 for expenses in taking two children to Kansas. All voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Maddox that \$5000.00 be transferred from the General Fund to the Officer's Salary Fund. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Maddox that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids for 4 carloads of creosoted bridge lumber, being 1 carload each for Precinct Nos. 1, 2, 3, & 4 to be delivered on or about November 1, 1945. Bids to be received Oct. 1, 1945. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".
