BE IT REMEMBERED that at a Special Meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 1st day of December A. D. 1945, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Maddox, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that all properly approved accounts be allowed and ordered paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the contract with Thompson Radio and Sound Service be renewed on the same terms as existed. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids to be opened on the 20th day of December A. D. 1945 at 10 o'clock a.m. for one crawler type tractor approximately 38 horsepower with front end loader of a 3/4 yard bucket capacity. Time warrants due 1 and 2 years after date at 4% per annum will be issued in payment. This tractor is for Precinct #4. The Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.
