BE IT REMEMBERED that at a Regular Meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 11th day of February, 1946, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Maddox, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that all properly approved accounts be allowed and ordered paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids for 8 new short wheel base truck, chassis 1 ½ tons with standard equipment. There are to be two to each precinct.

The trade-in of one 1939 V-8 Ford truck and one 1938 Chevrolet truck belonging to Precinct #1. Also one 1937 V-8 Ford truck and one 1940 V-8 Ford truck belonging to Precinct #2.

Bids are to be received by 10:00 a.m. on March 1, 1946. The Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids for tractor and ¾ yard front end loader for Precinct #3. Bids to be received not later than 10:00 a.m. March 1, 1946. The court reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the County Treasurer be authorized to transfer \$10,000 from the General Fund to the Officer's Salary Fund. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted ""Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the County Auditor be authorized to advertise for bids for 1935 Chevrolet pick-up to be sold by Precinct #2. Bids to be received not later than 10:00 a.m. March 1, 1946. The Court reserves the right to reject any and all bids. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".
