The Commissioners Court acting as a Board of Equalization met on the $19^{\text {th }}$ and $20^{\text {th }}$ of June 1946, and after hearing all complaints, and making such adjustments as considered equitable and just, the following order was passed:

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the valuations fixed by the Equalization Board remain as fixed by the Board where no change has been made, and that the valuation fixed on all property by the Tax Assessor on the unrendered roll be fixed as assessed by the Assessor, and that the Tax Assessor-Collector be instructed to prepare the Roll on the valuation as assessed and as fixed by the Equalization Board.

Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted aye.
