BE IT REMEMBERED THAT at a regular meeting of the Commissioners’ Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 8th day of July, 1946, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Maddox, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that all properly approved accounts be allowed and ordered paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted “Aye”.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Tax Assessor and Collector be authorized to cancel the valuation heretofore placed against lots 28 to 31 in Block F, and lot 40, Block K of the Swope Addition to the town of Rio Vista, Texas and to reassess the same on the valuation to accept \$75.14 in full settlement of all taxes against the same. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted “Aye”.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Maddox that Roy Anderson be appointed to sell and dispose of a tract of land belonging to the County, being a lot in Sand Flat purchased from the Fundamental Baptist Church. Said land is to be sold at public auction to the highest bidder and said Roy Anderson is authorized to execute a deed to the purchaser. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted “Aye”.
