BE IT REMEMBERED THAT at a Special meeting of the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, held on the 1st day of August, 1946, the following members were present: Honorable Roy Anderson, County Judge, Commissioner Wyatt, Precinct #1, Commissioner Hadley, Precinct #2, Commissioner Maddox, Precinct #3, Commissioner Roland, Precinct #4, and A. T. Griffin, County Clerk. Among other things they did the following:

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that all properly approved accounts be allowed and ordered paid. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted "Aye".

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the petition of Byron Anderson et al to close a road in Rio Vista be rejected, a protest having been filed against the same. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Wyatt that the appointment of Miss Rachel McVicker as clerk in the County Attorney's office, beginning July 15, 1946 at a salary of \$75.00 per month be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Maddox that the application of A. T. Griffin to appoint Louis B. Lee as Deputy in the County Clerk's office be approved, beginning Aug. 1, 1946 at a salary of \$135.00 per month. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the List of Delinquent Tax Payers submitted by the Tax Collector be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that the List of Land & Lots delinquent on June 30, 1946 for Taxes of 1945 as submitted by W. J. Stilwell Tax Collector be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that Errors in Assessment submitted by W. J. Stilwell, Tax Collector and Assessor, be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted Aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Wyatt and seconded by Commissioner Roland that the Tax Collector and Assessor's Supplemental Assessment Roll submitted by W. J. Stilwell be approved. Commissioners Wyatt, Hadley, Maddox and Roland voted aye.
