Lee, County Clerk.

The meeting of the Commissioners' Court was called for the purpose of appointing a person to fill out the unexpired term of office of S. O. Rosser, Tax Collector and Assessor for Johnson County, Texas.

A motion was made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Roland that Clifford Duff be appointed Tax Collector and Assessor for Johnson County for the unexpired term of office of S. O. Rosser, deceased, effective upon qualifying with proper acceptable bond and oath of office. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Evans, seconded by Commissioner Roland that the County Auditor be authorized to close the office of the Tax Collector and Assessor and make a complete audit of the books, records, and money and to close out all business for Mr. S. O. Rosser, Deceased. Judge J. P. Seroyer is authorized to assist the County Auditor in making the audit of the Tax Collector and Assessor record. All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Maddox, Seconded by Commissioner Coward that this Commissioner Court meeting be adjourned until 2:00 o'clock P.M. August 22, 1950 at which time the Bond of Clifford Duff as Tax Collector and Assessor will be considered. All voted aye.
