Coward, Commissioner Precinct No. 1, S. W. Evans, Commissioner Precinct No. 2; V. L. Maddox, Commissioner Precinct No. 3; M. W. Roland, Commissioner Precinct No. 4, H. G. Littlefair, County Judge, and Louis B. Lee, County Clerk, when the following, among other proceedings were had:

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland, Seconded by Commissioner Coward that the bid of Browning-Ferris Machinery Co. be accepted, bid as follows:

"1 - Jaeger Model 3 1/2 ST Concrete Mixer; powered with Wisconsin Model AKN, air colled gasoline engine, 3-3/4 HP, at 2100 RPM, mounted on two 500 x 16 pneumatic tires. Weight approximately 1,035 lbs. F.O.B., Dallas, \$617.00. Delivery: From stock. Terms: Net 30 days."
