BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEEGTING of the Commissioners' Court on the above mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, the following members were present: Ted W. Myatt, County Judge; Presiding; W. M. Coward, Commissioner of Precinct No.1; W. R. Bryant, Commissioner of Precinct No.2; J. C. (Jim) Rayburne, Commissioner of Precinct No.3; and Louis B. Lee, County Clerk.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Coward that the \$30,000.00 which was invested in a time deposit at 3 per cent interest at the Cleburne National Bank in January 1963 from the right-of-way fund be reinvested for a six month period with the Cleburne National Bank at 3 per cent interest.

All voted aye

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant approving resolutions below.

RESOLUTION

That the County Judge of Johnson County be, and he is hereby authorized to accept Four Thousand Ninety-four and 70/100 Dollars (\$4,094.70) on behalf of Johnson County in full settlement of a claim against the Santa Fe Railroad for certain cedar posts belonging to the County which were destroyed by fire, said fire occurring on February 25, 1963. It is further provided that on receipt of the said Four Thousand Ninety-four and 70/100 Dollars (\$4,094.70) from the Santa Fe Railroad, the County Judge of Johnson County shall be authorized to execute a release to said Railroad fully releasing it from any and all claims which Johnson County might assert arising out of the said fire on February 25, 1963.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Coward that Mrs. Stella Martin be employed as Deputy in the County Clerk's office effective July 8, 1963 at salary of \$200.00 per month.

All voted aye

A motion was made by Commissioner Coward and seconded by Commissioner Roland approving resolutions accepting the provisions of State Highway Commission Minute Orders.
