WHEREAS, The Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, set the salaries of certain officials of Johnson County, Texas, at 6300.00 per annum; beginning January $1^{\rm st}$, 1963.

WHEREAS, included therein was Homer F. Wicker, Court Reporter of Johnson County, Texas, and, WHEREAS, Art. 2326 of the Texas Civil Statures provided that the salary of the Court Reporter for the District Court of Johnson County and Somervell County, Texas, being the 18th Judicial District Court of Texas, shall be set by the Judge of said Court; and also provided that same shall be not to exceed \$6600.00 annually;

AND, WHEREAS, because of the above statute Homer F. Wicker, Court Reporter of Johnson County, Texas, was prohibited from drawing over \$6,168.00 from Johnson County, Texas, and therefore, said salary was changed from \$6300.00 to \$6168.00 annually; and

WHEREAS, the 58th Legislature of the State of Texas, at its regular session in 1963, passed a bill raising the maximum salary of said Court Reporter to \$7500.00; therefore, beginning September 1st, 1963, IT IS ORDERED that Official Court Reporter for the District Court of Johnson County, Texas,

shall receive an annual salary of \$6300.00 from Johnson County, Texas, payable in monthly installments of \$525.00; said above mentioned Court Reporter's bill having gone into effect August 23, 1963.
