BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, with the following members present: Hershel C. Winn, County Judge, W.M. Coward, Commissioner of Precinct No.1; W.R. Bryant, Commissioner of Precinct No.2; J.C. Rayburne, M.W. Roland, Commissioner of Precinct No.4; Louie B. Lee, County Clerk, Lorene Moreland, County Auditor, and O. Odell Elliott, Assistant County Auditor and John Butner.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that all bills against Johnson County be allowed and ordered paid as presented and examined in open court and properly endorsed.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Coward that the County Auditor be authorized to transfer \$15,000.00 from the General Fund into 90 day time warrant account at the Cleburne National Bank to bear interest, and \$15,000.00 each from R&B Precincts Number 1 and 4 into 6 months time warrant account at the Cleburne National Bank to bear interest.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Coward that it be resolved that the Commissioners Court hereby sets a policy that they will not approve any shuck for expenses that is not supported or documented by a receipt or statement except in the case of shuck for postage, salaries or mileage.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Bryant that the following resolution be adopted and made of record in the Commissioner's Court minutes.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners Court of Johnson County Texas hereby requests that the U.S. Department of Agriculture through the F.H.A. declare Johnson County as a disaster area so that the individuals meeting the necessary requirements may obtain low interest loans and other benefits.

All voted aye.
