The meeting was called for the purpose of Tax Equalization by the Commissioners Court as required by law.

Board of Equalization Oath of members, as follows:

"We, Thomas E. Ball, County Judge, C. W. Atwood, W. R. Bryant, W. I. Boteler and M. W. Roland, Commissioners, members of the Board of Equalization of Johnson County for the year A.D. 1970, hereby solemnly swear that, in the performance of our duties as members of such board for said year, we will not vote to allow any taxable property to stand assessed on the tax rolls of said county for said year at any sum which we believe to be less than its true market value; that we will faithfully endeavor and as members of said board will move to have each item of taxable property which we believe to be assessed for said year at less than its true market value, or real value, raised on the tax rolls to what we believe to be its true cash market value, if it has a market value, and if not, then to its real value; and that we will faithfully endeavor to have the assessed valuation of all property subject to taxation within said county stand upon the tax rolls of said county for said year at its true market value, or if it has no market value then its real value. We further solemnly swear that we have read and understand the provisions contained in the Constitution and Laws of this State relative to the valuation of taxable property, and that we will faithfully perform all the duties required of us under the Constitution and Laws of this State.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland and seconded by Commissioner Boteler that Glenn Mitchell be Temporarily Employed building manager for the Courthouse & Jail at a salary of \$400.00 per month. The Building Manager is empowered to supervise the janitorial service and the purchase of janitorial supplies, receive bids on repairs of any nature on the courthouse and jail, then confer with the Commissioners' Court. Employ custodian at a salary of \$325.00 per month, and in addition employ day laborers when needed at \$1.65 per hour. It is contemplated also that the Building Manager use Trustees from the jail to the fullest extent, regular supplies used by the Courthouse and jail, including automobile repairs, gas and oil, tires, etc. in addition the Building Manager will also be used in the purchase of Right of Way for use of County and State Highway when needed.

The above order in whole becomes effective July 1, 1970, and expires October 1, 1970.
