The following bids on carpeting of the County Courtroom; Tarver Carpet Company, Sherwin-Williams, and Hancock; the bid of Hancock being the low bid, in the amount of \$537.60.

A motion was made by Commissioner Roland, seconded by Commissioner Bryant, to accept the bid of Hancock in the amount of \$537.60 for carpeting the County Courtroom.
