A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Hadley that all bills against Johnson County be allowed and ordered paid, as submitted, examined in open court, and properly endorsed.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Atwood to enter into the following Agreement with the State of Texas:

STATE OF TEXAS : COUNTY OF TRAVIS :

THIS AGREEMENT, made this 10 day of May, 1971, by and between Johnson County, Texas, hereinafter called the "County", Party of the First Part, acting by and through its Commissioners Court and the State of Texas, hereinafter called the "State", Party of the Second Part, acting by and through its State Highway Commission.

WHEREAS, the County desires the installation of a 72" Reinforced Concrete Pipe at Station 246+00 on Farm to Market Road No. 1192 to be used as a stockpass and the State will, among other things, provide for the construction of this work within these limits and the County will contribute a fixed amount of Six Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$600.00), in payment for their portion of this work.

NOW THEREFORE, it is understood that this proposed work will be constructed by the State and the County will transmit to the State with the return of this agreement, executed by the County, a warrant made payable to the State Treasurer, Account of Trust Fund No. 927 in the amount of Six Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$600.00). It is further understood that the State will construct only those items for the County as requested and it is further understood that the contribution of Six Hundred and No/100 Dollars (\$600.00), by the County shall be a fixed amount for their share of the work.
