Townes, County Clerk.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Atwood to approve the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on November 2, 1971 the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas authorized the County Judge to file an application for a grant with the Texas Criminal Justice Council, said grant being in the sum of \$42,106.50 for a two-year period, 75% to be paid by the grant and 25% to be paid by Johnson and Somervell Counties, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the said grant has been approved by the Texas Criminal Justice Council for the first year in the amount of \$25,567.00, \$6,692.00 to be contributed by Johnson and Somervell Counties:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, does by these presents approve said grant and has amended its budget to cover its portion of the \$6,692.00 representing the County's share of the 25% of the grant authorized for the first year.
