BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, with the following members present: Thomas E. Ball, County Judge; C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Prec. #1; O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Prec. #2; W.I. Boteler, Commissioner Prec. #3; B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Prec. #4 and Joe L. Townes, County Clerk.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge that the County employ Mrs. Mildred Tucker as custodian of the ladies' lounge on the first floor of the courthouse at \$123.30 per month, and as operator of the concession stand on a trial bases until December 31, 1972; effective June 1, 1972.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to approve the payment of the monthly bills.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to approve the Treasurer's report January 1, 1972 through March 31, 1972.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to authorize the County Auditor to hire an employee at \$1.50 per hour, unless a member of the courthouse personnel is available to act as mail clerk, under the supervision of the County Auditor. The Mail Clerk will be the only unauthorized person to sue the stamp machine.

The Commissioners' Court agreed to accept the recommendation of Mrs. Tom J. Cunningham, District Home Demonstration Agent regarding the appointment of an assistant County Home Demonstration Agent for Johnson County.
