Townes, County Clerk.

The invocation was given by Commissioner C.W. Atwood.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to accept the plat of Section I, Oak Haven Estates, for filing upon the placing of \$7,350.00 by C.C. Williams in the County Depository.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to adopt the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, that the following resolution concerning notice of public hearing by the Texas Water Quality Board be adopted:

"At the request of the Johnson County Commissioners' Court the Texas Water Quality Board will conduct a public hearing on Wednesday, November 1, 1972, convening at 2:00 P.N. in the County Courtroom, Johnson County Courthouse, Cleburne, Texas.

"The purpose of this public hearing will be to obtain evidence concerning the need for establishing an order regulating the use of private sewage facilities (septic tank system) throughout unincorporated areas of Johnson County.

"Everyone with an interest in this matter is invited to attend this public hearing and to participate in the discussion."

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to purchase a Group Life Insurance for the Commissioners' Precinct workers and five (5) field deputies of the Sheriff's Department; \$2,000.00 each employee.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to approve the payment of monthly bills.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to continue the practice of the following resolution:

"Resolved it has long been the policy of Johnson County in reference to county prisoners medical and/or hospital treatment that the County is only liable where the County prisoner is treated by the County Health Officer or is admitted to the hospital by the County Health Officer."

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to approve the following request for Criminal Investigator's grant.
