BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas with the following members present: Thomas E. Ball, County Judge; C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No.1; O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Precinct No.2; W.I. Boteler, Commissioner No.3; B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No.4; Joe L. Townes, County Clerk.

A motion was made by Commissioner Atwood and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to approve Public Weigher's Bond #AE 71108-54 in the amount of \$2,500.00, Weldon D Edwards, bounden from 5-30-73 to 5-30-075.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No. 1 and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to authorize the City of Cleburne permission to sell to the highest bidder by sealed bids the following lots: East 1/2 of Lot 1, Block 244, original Cleburne; Lot 1, Block 274, original Cleburne; Lot 4 Block 314, original Cleburne. After deducting court costs of \$30.00 and publication costs of \$42.50 each lot, the proceeds are to be divided between the three taxing jurisdictions.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to amend the sheriff's budget to include a dispatcher-jailer for the 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. shift at \$400.00 per month effective 7-1-73.

All voted aye.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Atwood to authorize payment of the monthly bills as read by County Auditor Robert Wylie.
