BE IT REMEMBERED AT A SPECIAL MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, with the following members present: Thomas E. Ball, County Judge; C.W. Atwood, Commissioner Precinct No.1; O.B. Hadley, Commissioner Precinct No.2; W.I. Boteler, Commissioner Precinct NO. 3; B.B. Aldridge, Commissioner Precinct No.4; Joe L. Townes, County Clerk.

The invocation was given by Commissioner Hadley.

Also present were John MacLean, County Attorney, and Robert Wylie, County Auditor.

The rural fire department chiefs requested a total of \$86,000.00, payable over a four-year period from Revenue Sharing Funds, to be paid to the Rural Fire Departments of Johnson County.

A motion was made by Commissioner Boteler and seconded by Commissioner Atwood to budget a total of \$50,000.00 over a four-year period from the Revenue Sharing Funds, as long as Revenue Sharing Funds are received, to the rural fire departments.

Judge Ball substituted to amend the motion to include \$86,000.00 instead of \$50,000.00. The amendment died for lack of a second.

The following voted aye: Commissioner Atwood and Commissioner Boteler.

The following voted no: Judge Ball; Commissioner Hadley and Commissioner Aldridge.

A motion was made by Commissioner Hadley and seconded by Commissioner Aldridge to budget a total of \$60,000.00 over a four-year period from the

Revenue Sharing funds, as long as Revenue Sharing funds are received, to the Rural Fire Departments.

The following voted aye: Judge Ball; Commissioner Hadley and Commissioner Aldridge.

The following voted no: Commissioner Atwood and Commissioner Boteler and Judge Ball.

THERE BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS, Court adjourned.
