BE IT REMEMBERED AT A REGULAR MEETING OF THE COMMISSIONERS' COURT IN AND FOR JOHNSON COUNTY, TEXAS, on the above-mentioned date at the courthouse in Cleburne, Texas, with the following members present: <a href="C.C."Kit" Cooke">C.C. "Kit" Cooke</a> County Judge; Commissioner Precinct No.1 <a href="C.W. Atwood">C.W. Atwood</a>; Commissioner Precinct No.2 <a href="O.B.">O.B.</a> Hadley ; Commissioner Precinct No.3 <a href="W.I. Boteler">W.I. Boteler</a>; Commissioner Precinct No.4 <a href="B.B.">B.B. Aldridge</a> and Joe L. Townes County Clerk.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Boteler.

Attorney's Tommy Altaras and Dan Boulware representatives of the Johnson County Bar Association appeared before the court requesting their support in the creation of a new District Court concurrent with the present District Court lines. The court will consider a resolution at the next regular court meeting March 10, 1975.

A bill from the Tarrant County Hospital District in the amount of \$294.58 for hospitalization and treatment of Daniel Conner, Rt. 2 Box 592 Burleson, Texas was presented to the court. Judge Cooke is to make a determination on the following and represent his report at the March 10, 1975 court meeting:

- 1. Did the patient seek hospitalization at the Johnson County Memorial Hospital?
- 2. Is the patient indigent?

The election Judges of Box 10 Burleson and Box 6 Brazos Valley are asked to meet with the County Tax Collector to work out new election lines for a new election box at Burleson, splitting box 10 and the discontinuance of Box 6 Brazos Valley.
