A quoram was present.

Invocation was given by W.I. Boteler

Commissioner C.W. Atwood presided in the absence of Judge Cooke.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Boteler to approve previous minutes as read by the County Clerk for the regular meeting July 12th and the special meeting of July 19th.

A motion was made by Commissioner Aldridge and seconded by Commissioner Hadley to approve payment of monthly bills as read by the Auditor.

Mr. Max M. Sanders appeared before the court in regard to the cost of 10,000 up dated current county road maps @ \$2,800.00 and fifty large size 60" maps to be included. There was no decision reached and it will be placed on the agenda for the August 9, 1976 meeting.
