Comm. York, decided to study all bids received before making a final decision. Bids were received for a chip spreader, tractor, tractor and mower, and gravel trailers for Precinct 3. No action taken.

Bids for the sale of a 1977 Chevrolet truck tractor in as is condition from Precinct 2 were received from Tolbert Worley, Jr., in the amount of \$600.00; and L.W. Brinkley in amount of \$1,200.00.

Motion by Comm. Russell, second by Comm. Roe, to accept the bid from L.W. Brinkley in the amount of \$1,200.00 for the purchase of a 1977 C-65 Chevrolet truck-tractor. All voted aye; motion passed.

SUBDIVISIONS

1. Sunshine Country Acres

Motion by Comm. York, second by Comm. Aldridge, to approve the revision of the preliminary plat of Sunshine Country Acres. All voted aye; motion passed.

2. Barton Acres

Motion by Comm. Russell, second by Comm. Roe, to accept roads for county maintenance in Barton Acres subdivision.
