BE IT KNOWN that on the 17th day of August, 1992, the Honorable Commissioners' Court of Johnson County, Texas, met in special session with all members present in the Courthouse in the City of Cleburne, Johnson County, Texas and the following items were considered:

AWARD BID ON PEWS AND CONFEDRENCE TABLES FOR THE DISTRICT COURTS BUILDING

A motion was made by Comm. Harmon, seconded by Comm. Hewlett, to approve the low bids of Ward and Sons for pews, in the amount of \$19,434.00; and of Alfa Associates for conference tables, in the amount of \$5,075.00, for the District Court Building.

All voted aye; motion passed.

AGREEMENT WITH MINYARD STORE TO SELL LICENSE TAG RENEWALS

A motion was made by Comm. Harmon, seconded by Comm. Estes, to approve the Johnson County Tax Assessor-Collector be authorized to enter into an agreement with Minyard's Food Stores, in Burleson, whereby Minyard's will provide vehicle license tag renewals. Also, that the County Judge be authorized to sign the agreement on behalf of the Commissioners' Court.

All voted aye; motion passed.

REGISTRATION FEES FOR ROADS AND BRIDGES; SCHOOL CROSSING GUARDS

A motion was made by Comm. Hewlett, seconded by Comm. Estes, that Johnson County exercise the option and no collect the additional \$1.50 per license renewal for school crossing guards.

All voted aye; motion passed.

A motion was made by Comm. Estes, seconded by Comm. Hewlett, that Johnson County continue to collect the optional \$10.00 fee on vehicle renewal for road and bridges.

All voted aye; motion passed.

BUDGET WORKSHOP

The 1992 - 1993 budget for Johnson County was discussed.
