Thompson to hire 6 additional full-time and 10 additional part-time Detention Officers at the Juvenile Detention Center at a salary equal to the Sheriff's Department Jailors and for the current Detention Officers to be upgraded to meet the new salary. The part-time Detention Officer pool will not exceed 30 hours per week. The motion will also give Judge Harmon the authority to purchase any additional items necessary to repair the Juvenile Detention Center in order to have it meet TJPC and State Fire Marshall standards.

All voted aye, motion passed.

There being no further business before the Court concerning this Agenda, the Court adjourned on the same date at 9:03 a.m.
