COMMISSIONER'S COURT

BE IT KNOWN that on the 1st day of April, 2002, the Honorable Commissioner's Court of Johnson County, Texas, met in special session at the Courthouse thereof, in the City of Cleburne, Johnson County, Texas, for the purpose of transacting any and all business that may lawfully be brought before the same. The meeting was called to order at 8:30 A.M. and with all members present, with the exception of Comm. Troy Thompson, and the following items, having been lawfully posted and filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk on March 26, 2002, at 11:20 A.M., were considered:

I. ACTION TO PURCHASE TWO MOBILE RADIOS AND ONE HAND HELD RADIO: CONSTABLE PRECINCT #2

Comm. Harmon, seconded by Comm. McFall, made a motion to approve the purchase of two mobile radios and one hand held radio for the Constables Office in Precinct #2.

All voted aye; motion carried.

II. ACTION TO APPROVE PURCHASE OF CARPET FOR ADULT PROBATION

Comm. McFall, seconded by Comm. Harmon, made a motion to approve the purchase of carpet from Carpet Care in the amount of \$6888.75 for Adult Probation to be taken from the courthouse building repair line item.

All voted aye; motion carried.

III. ACTION ON CONTRACT WITH PETE DURANT & ASSOCIATES, INC. CONCERNING THE GUINN JUSTICE CENTER

Comm. Harmon, seconded by Comm. Carpenter, made a motion to

accept the contract including Maximum Cost Exhibit with Pete Durant & Associates, Inc. with the guarantee that the maximum cost to Johnson County for the demolition and construction of the Guinn Justice Center in accordance with the specifications previously submitted by Alan Magee shall not exceed ten million dollars (\$10,000,000.00) and giving the County Judge authority to sign the contract.

All voted aye; motion carried.

There being no further business before the Court concerning this agenda, Commissioner's Court adjourned at 9:10 A.M. on the same date.
