- b. BOND TO JOHNSON COUNTY IN THE AMOUNT OF
\$100,000
- c. PUBLIC EMPLOYEE FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE BOND
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50,000

Carpenter, made a motion to approve a bond to the State of Texas in the amount of \$100,000.00 and a bond to Johnson County in the amount of \$100,000.00 and a Public Employee Faithful Performance Bond in the amount of \$50,000.00 for Scott Porter, Tax Assessor/Collector.
