CONSIDERATION OF SUBMITTING A LETTER TO OFFICE OF THE GOVERNOR, CRIMINAL JUSTICE DIVISION TO DISBAND MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL TASK FORCE (STOP THE OFFENDER PROGRAM NARCOTICS TASK FORCE) BY REQUESTING RETENTION AND DISTRIBUTION OF TASK FORCE ASSETS INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO EQUIPMENT AND GENERATED PROGRAM INCOME TO PARTICIPATING AGENCIES THE FORMULATION OF SINGLE COUNTY RESPONSES TO FURTHER STRATEGIC DRUG DEMAND REDUCTION
