BE IT KNOWN that on the 23rd day of December, 2013, the Honorable Commissioner's Court of Johnson County, Texas, met in Regular Session at the Johnson County Courthouse thereof, in the City of Cleburne, Johnson County, Texas, for the purpose of transacting any and all business that may lawfully be brought before the same. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M., with all members present, and following the Invocation led by Donald Bennett, and the Pledge of Allegiance, the following items, having been lawfully posted and filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk on December 19, 2013 at 9:33 A.M., were considered:

IV. WELCOME VISITORS, ANNOUNCEMENTS & PRESENTATIONS

Judge Harmon announced that Virgil Ward, long time Johnson County employee, passed away yesterday afternoon. He also announced that Carolyn McCoy, Chief Deputy for the District Clerks' Office passed away last week. Judge Harmon asked that everyone keep their families in our thoughts and prayers. He also wished everyone a Merry Christmas.

V. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

A. J. Mathieu spoke in regards to New Business #7 on this agenda. This item is for the Consideration of a Resolution Adopting the Power to Remove an Appointed Member of an Emergency Services District. Mr. Mathieu asked the Commissioner's Court to approve this Resolution.

VI. PUBLIC HEARINGS

The Commissioner's Court opened a Public Hearing at 9:07 A.M. to discuss:

Comm. Stringer spoke about the requirements for the County to designate zone(s) to qualify for the grant dollars to assist the County in repairing roads and bridges affected by the oil and gas industries. Comm. Stringer stressed this was not an additional tax for the taxpayers.

Comm. Bailey told the court that we have two (2) years to make the repairs, but the zone(s) would last ten (10) years. Judge Harmon spoke in favor of the CERTZ and said that the oil and gas companies favor it also. He also said it would not increase anyone's taxes in approving the zones. Comm. Beeson said he didn't want anyone to think that all County roads would be repaired using this money because of the amount of funding we would qualify for. Comm. Howell repeated this would not increase taxes for the taxpayer due to the money coming from the severance tax the oil and gas companies pay. There being no one else to present to speak, the hearing was closed at 9:17 A.M.
