The meeting was called to order at 9:00 A.M., with all members present, and following the Invocation led by Pastor Greg Robinson, Bono Baptist Church, and the Pledge of Allegiance, the following items, having been lawfully posted and filed for record in the Office of the County Clerk on May 7, 2015 at 1:08 P.M., were considered:
