I. NEW BUSINESS

1. PRESENTATION FROM FEMA REGARDING PROCEDURES FOR DECLARATION OF DISASTER FOR JOHNSON COUNTY

County Judge, Roger Harmon explained the purpose of today's meeting is to have FEMA update the Court on procedures the public need to follow for any needs they may have due to the Declaration of Disaster he issued for Johnson County. Judge Harmon thanked the news media for being present and assisting with getting the information out to the public.

Randy Meshell, Branch 1 Director – DR-4223-TX, for FEMA, spoke about the options available to citizens of Johnson County regarding damages sustained from the floods occurring during the Declaration of Disaster period.

Winifred Ballenger, Individual Household Program (IHP), FEMA, spoke regarding [how to apply for assistance with FEMA](#). She said the public can register by calling 1-800-621-FEMA or by visiting the website, www.fema.gov.

Cynthia Cowell, Public Information Officer, SBA spoke regarding how the public can qualify for low interest loans from the SBA for repairs to homes, to replace personal property including vehicles, and for businesses that have been damaged during this Declaration of Disaster. They can call the SBA at 1-800-659-2955 or can be referred directly by FEMA.

Jamie Moore, Emergency Management Coordinator for Johnson County concluded the meeting.

There being no further business before the Court concerning this agenda, Commissioners Court adjourned at 10:03 A.M.
