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**COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING A DISCRETIONARY EXEMPTION  
UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE  
BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT  
CODE, UPON A FINDING THAT THE UPGRADE TO THE SECURITY CAMERA  
SYSTEM AT THE GUINN JUSTICE CENTER IS AN ITEM NECESSARY TO  
PRESERVE OR PROTECT THE PUBLIC HEALTH OR SAFETY OF THE  
RESIDENTS OF JOHNSON COUNTY**

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The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on February 9, 2015 in a regularly scheduled session for the consideration of an upgrade the Security Camera System at the Guinn Justice Center. The Commissioners Court finds that the upgrade of the Security Camera System at the Guinn Justice Center is an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court may grant a discretionary exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Jerry Stringer and seconded by Commissioner Larry Woolley that: "The Commissioners Court find that the upgrade of the Security Camera System at the Guinn Justice Center is an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County and that the Commissioners Court grant a discretionary exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, regarding the upgrade of the Security Camera System at the Guinn Justice Center."

Said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2015.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:**

The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order granting a discretionary exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, for the upgrade the Security Camera System at the Guinn Justice Center upon the Commissioners Court finding that the upgrade of the Security Camera System at the Guinn Justice Center is an item necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the residents of Johnson County.




