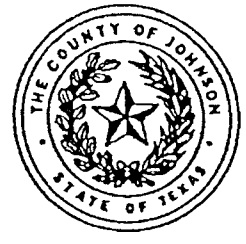

**COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE REPRESENTATION OF KIRK MANNING AND RALPH H. DUGGINS OF CANTY HANGER, L.L.P. IS FOR A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE**

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on May 14, 2015 in special session for the consideration of representation with Kirk Manning and Ralph H. Duggins of Canty Hanger, L.L.P. The Commissioners Court finds that this representation is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner LARRY WOOLLEY and seconded by Commissioner RICK BAILEY that: "The Commissioners Court find the representation with Kirk Manning and Ralph H. Duggins of Canty Hanger, L.L.P. is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the representation with Kirk Manning and Ralph H. Duggins of Canty Hanger, L.L.P.

Said motion was approved by unanimous vote of the Commissioners Court on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2015.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:**  
The Commissioners Court of Johnson County, Texas does hereby enter this order granting an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, upon the Commissioners Court finding that the representation with Kirk Manning and Ralph H. Duggins of Canty Hanger, L.L.P. is for a professional service.






