COMMISSIONERS COURT GRANTING AN EXEMPTION UNDER SECTION 262.024, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, FROM THE BIDDING REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 262.023, LOCAL GOVERNMENT CODE, UPON THE COMMISSIONERS COURT FINDING THAT THE REPRESENTATION OF MCCREARY, VESELKA, BRAGG, AND ALLEN, P.C. IS FOR A PROFESSIONAL SERVICE

The Johnson County Commissioners Court met on July 27, 2015 in regular session for the consideration of representation by McCreary, Veselka, Bragg, & Allen, P.C. The Commissioners Court finds that this representation is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court may grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code.

A motion was made by Commissioner Bailey and seconded by Commissioner Woolley that: "The Commissioners Court find the representation by McCreary, Veselka, Bragg, & Allen, P.C. for the collection of delinquent court fees and fines is for a professional service and that the Commissioners Court grant an exemption under Section 262.024, Local Government Code, from the competitive bidding requirements of Section 262.023, Local Government Code, and enter an order to that affect, and that the Commissioners Court approve the representation by McCreary, Veselka, Bragg, & Allen, P.C. for the collection of delinquent court fees and fines.

Said motion was approved by a vote of the Commissioners Court on the 27th day of July, 2015.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED:




