### Fuel Tank Project:

The unleaded fuel tank at the Precinct 4 yard is a single walled horizontal steel tank that has no containment device or structure. (See Pictures attached)

This was noted in Isaac Garcia's PROPERTY SURVEY that was conducted in January, 2016. While researching this problem and discussing this with Jeff Bowman at TEEX, it was also determined that NFPA requires that these tanks be constructed out of a Fireguard material since it is so close in proximity to a building.

We are proposing the installation of a new double walled Fireguard 2000 gallon unleaded fuel tank to replace the existing tank. This will bring the unleaded tank into full compliance.

The quote for the unleaded fuel tank is in the amount of \$15,652. (See quote attached)

*Note: The existing diesel fuel tank will also need to be replaced in the future in Phase II of this proposal to be considered in a new budget year.*
