TAX ABATEMENT PROJECT SOUTHWEST

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Johnson County, held on the 22nd day of May, 2017, on motion made by Commissioner Kenny Howell, and seconded by Commissioner Larry Woolley, the following Order was adopted:


WHEREAS, Johnson County and Golden State Foods Corporation entered into a Tax Abatement Agreement providing for an Abatement of fifty percent of the increased value over a seven year period beginning on January 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, due to circumstances beyond its control, Golden State Foods Corporation has been unable to begin construction of the improvements in the time frame set forth in said agreement and wishes the abatement to begin January 1, 2020; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the Commissioners Court hereby and herewith authorizes the County Judge to execute an amendment to the abatement agreement between Johnson County and Golden State Foods Corporation with an effective date of January 1, 2020.


