2ND AMENDMENT TO TAX ABATEMENT PROJECT SOUTHWEST

BE IT REMEMBERED, at a regular meeting of the Commissioners Court of Johnson County, held on the 29TH day of May, 2018, on motion made by Commissioner Kenny Howell, and seconded by Commissioner Jerry Stringer, the following Order was adopted:

WHEREAS, Johnson County and Golden State Food Corporation aka Project Southwest previously entered into an abatement agreement providing for an abatement of 50% of the increased value over a 7 year period beginning on January 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, said Agreement mentioned has been amended to begin January 1, 2020; and

WHEREAS, Golden State Foods Corporation has decided to increase its capital investment within this time frame; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the Commissioner's Court hereby and herewith authorizes the County Judge to execute an Amendment to the abatement agreement between Johnson County and Golden State Food Corporation to provide for a percentage abatement of 75% for a period of nine years.






