The meeting was called to order at 9:01 A.M. with all members present. ### PUBLIC ANNOUNCEMENTS

**PA1.** Announcements from County Commissioners Regarding County and Precinct Events

Comm. Bailey stated that he wanted to recognize and give respect to Mr. David Murdoch. He added that he was a champion of this county and loved it and did so much for Johnson County. He said that he poured his time and his own money into the Chisholm Trail Outdoor Museum for people to enjoy for years to come. He gave thanks to him and his family.

Comm Howell reminded the Court that this Thursday night, there will be a Candidate Meet and Greet at the Cleburne Conference Center at 6:30 P.M. and that it will be put on by TPUSA Faith.

Comm. Woolley gave a shout-out to the Junior Livestock Show. He stated that they had a huge show last week where all the FFA and 4-H youth participated in the County Livestock Show and the premium auction. Comm. Woolley said at the end of the day, the sale price was hovering around \$800,000.00, and that it was up substantially from last year. He added that it was probably the biggest one-day charitable event in this county. He congratulated the FFA members and 4-H youth. Comm. Woolley said that the 4-H livestock judging team went to Denver and that they were named the Reserve National Champion. He added that placing that high qualifies them for a world event to go to Scotland this summer.

Comm White stated that the \$800,000.00 was 291 kids or 291 lots and that it says a lot for the generosity of this county.
